- 4. Would Uriah be described as a faithful soldier or a unfaithful soldier (11:11)?
- 5. Was the Lord pleased with David (11:27)?



## NATHAN REBUKES DAVID

Read II Samuel 12:1-25

Who said...

- 1. "As the Lord liveth, the man that hath done this thing shall surely die." (12:5)
- 2. "Thou art the man." (12:7)
- 3. "For thou didst it secretly: but I will do this thing before all Israel, and before the sun." (12:12)
- 4. "I have sinned against the Lord." (12:13)
- 5. "The Lord also hath put away thy sin; thou shalt not die." (12:13)

- 2. Who did this man use to persuade the king to bring Absalom back (14:4)?
- 3. What did Absalom do to get Joab's attention (14:30)?
- 4. What happened at the meeting of Absalom and King David (14:33)?
- 5. How did Absalom steal the hearts of the men of Israel (15:5-6)?
